Global investors & decisionmakers will convene at the 10th EAIF to electrify underserved communities worldwide

Investors and decision-makers in the decentralised renewable energy (DRE) sector from around the world will gather in **Kampala, Uganda**, on **8-10 April 2025** for the sector's leading annual event – the ARE Energy Access Investment Forum ([EAIF 2025](#)).

EAIF 2025 is organised by the Alliance for Rural Electrification, and supported by GET.invest, a European programme mobilising investment in renewable energy. GET.invest is co-funded by the European Union, Germany, Norway, the Netherlands, Sweden and Austria. **The forum is held under the patronage of the Ministry of Energy & Mineral Development of Uganda.**
