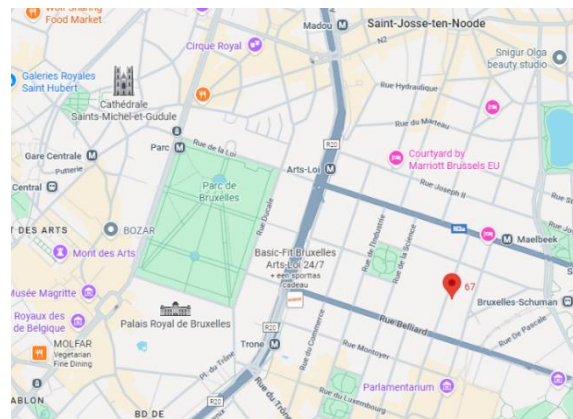
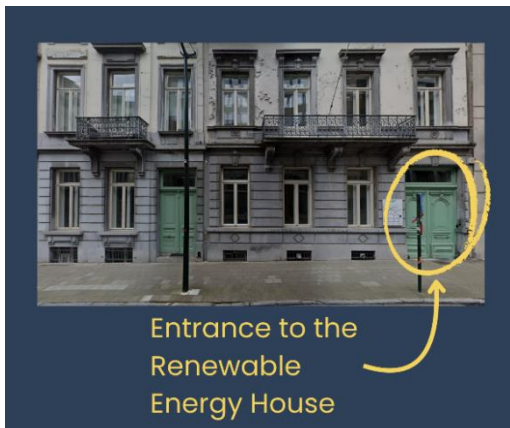




Logistical Note

Organised by the Alliance for Rural Electrification (ARE), the Industry Action Dialogue (IAD) 2025 will take place on the 4th of December in Brussels, Belgium at the Renewable Energy House (REH) in [Rue d'Arlon 63-67](#). All participants are asked to make their own arrangements for both travel and accommodation at their own expense.



How to reach IAD From Brussels Central Station

To reach IAD 2025 from Brussels Central Station, ARE recommends the following options:

- **Metro Line 1** towards Stokkel/Stockel and **stop at Meelbeek/Maelbeek** station. From there, it is just a 5 minutes' walk to reach ARE offices.
- **Metro Line 5** towards Herrmann-Debroux and **stop at Meelbeek/Maelbeek** station.
- **Taxis** are available outside the train station or can be booked through Uber.

From Brussels Zaventem Airport

To reach IAD 2025 from Brussels Zaventem Airport, ARE recommends the following options:

- **Suburban train** towards Charleroi-Central and **stop at Brussels – Schumann** station. From there, it is approximately a 8 minutes' walk to reach ARE offices.



- **Bus 12** towards City Centre and **stop at Meelbeek/Maelbeek**. From there, it is approximately a 8 minutes' walk to reach ARE offices.

From Brussels Zaventem Airport

If you are reaching IAD 2025 by car, ARE recommends the following parking options:
